## Apostrophes 3

Apostrophes can be used in your writing to show possession—to say, "Hey, that belongs to me!" (See 604.4 and 606.1–606.4 in *Write Source* for more details about how to use apostrophes to show possession.)

## **Examples**

Singular Possessives:

Cedar Point's Mean Streak roller coaster is one of the world's longest wooden coasters.

Plural Possessives:

The visitors, hearts raced as they plunged down the coaster hills.

Shared Possession:

Latoya, Eli, and Gabriel's favorite roller coaster is the Wild Thing at Valleyfair. Latoya's, Eli's, and Gabriel's favorite snacks are different.

Possessives in Compound Nouns:

My sister-in-law's biggest fear is falling out of a roller coaster.


Possessives with Indefinite Pronouns:

Everyone's hands grab the safety bar during loops.
